Quiz Rules

§1. General Provisions

- The quiz is organized by Unmanned Systems Poland and RMUS.
- The quiz takes place via the AhaSlides platform.

§2. Participation

• All individuals eligible to attend the Logis-Mil trade fair who are at least 15 years old may participate in the quiz.

- Participation in the quiz is free of charge.
- Each participant may only take part once.

• Only individuals who are physically present at the Logis-Mil trade fair, under the stage where the event is taking place, may participate.

§3. Quiz Procedure

• The quiz consists of one round with 34 questions. In the event of a tie, a tiebreaker round of 10 additional questions will be held.

- The time to answer each question is 50 seconds.
- Each question has only one correct answer.
- Once an answer has been submitted, it cannot be changed or returned

to.

- The quiz includes questions and answers in both English and Polish.
- Participants answer the questions in real time using internet-enabled devices.

• Scoring in the main round ranges from 0 to 1 point per question. In the tiebreaker round, scores range from 0 to 100 points per question. In the tiebreaker, points are awarded based on both correctness and response time.

§4. Question Topics

- The questions cover, among others, the following areas:
 - drone knowledge,
 - legal regulations regarding drone usage,
 - safety rules,

- the use of AI in technologies,
- military-related topics.

• Question sources include available publications, legal regulations, and educational materials.

§5. Prize

• The participant who scores the highest number of points wins.

• The prize is a drone, sponsored by Unmanned Systems Poland and RMUS.

• If the winner is under 18 years of age, they must collect the prize on stage accompanied by a guardian.

§6. Final Provisions

• The organizer's decisions regarding the course of the quiz and dispute resolution are final.

- The organizer reserves the right to amend the rules in justified cases.
- Participation in the quiz implies acceptance of these rules.
